

Tropaia Ceremony and Awards Nominations

The SCS Tropaia Ceremony will take place on Wednesday, May 18 at 6 p.m. in Gaston Hall. Tropaia is the ancient Greek word for "trophies," and refers to a monument constructed to celebrate a military victory. The Tropaia Ceremony is the event where individual schools distribute awards. Ignatian Student Award

This award honors a student who embodies Georgetown's Ignatian values of Faith and Justice and of Men and Women for Others. While maintaining a strong academic record, this recipient continues to make a positive community impact through service to others.

Eligibility: All students of degree-awarding programs (BALS, MALS, DLS, MPS) who graduated this past academic year, August 2010/December 2010, or who are eligible to graduate in May 2011.

Spirit of Georgetown Award

This award honors an alumnus or alumna who has exemplified Georgetown values and traditions – service to others, academic excellence, commitment to justice and common good, intellectual openness, and leadership.

Eligibility: All alumni of degree-awarding programs (BALS, MALS, DLS, MPS) who graduated between 1975 and May 2010.
